

# Christmas Servant Event or Learning Fair Opportunities

## December 2022:

- 1. Servant Event:** Set up and decorate a Christmas tree (provided) in the South Sunday School Classroom. The tree needs to have lights and I have Chrismons to decorate it (white and gold – also provided). This needs to be set up by Next Wednesday, Dec 4<sup>th</sup>. ***This could count as a learning fair project if you displayed information about the Chrismons and created a few of your own. Make sure you take pics along the way to display at the learning fair.***
- 2. Servant Event:** I'm looking for someone to handle setting out Christmas cards and making sure people sign them for our home-bound members. I will have address labels and postage for you. The need to be set out the night of December 21 by 5:00 pm & mailed the next day. You could also write a little message to the recipients if you want. I have a sign you can hang up near the table. ***This could count as a learning Fair project if you personally write messages in each card. You would need to document with pictures and present it the night of the learning fair.***
- 3. Servant Event:** We need someone to help set up tables for the Family Christmas event meal & activities. You would be **coordinating with Russ** for after school on Wednesday, Dec 21. You would need to make sure tables are wiped off, and set out the provided decorations.
- 4. Learning Fair Project:** I'm looking for a tech-savvy young person who can put together a video for a Christmas song. You would be responsible for taking the following pictures, putting the song lyrics on the screen somehow. All costumes & props are provided. I will have the youth band play "Hark the Herald" during this time. Something like this:

Hymn: Hark! The Herald Angels Sing Video Clip

Hark! The herald angels sing, (pic of angels)

"Glory to the newborn King; (pic of Grades 2-3 with crowns for the king)

Peace on earth and mercy mild, (pic of Grades K-1 around the globe)

God and sinners reconciled!" (pic of 4:12 with letters to spell "RECONCILED")

Joyful, all ye nations, rise, (pic of Donna, Russ, Kristin, Vicar looking excited & joyful)

Join the triumph of the skies; (pic of grades 4-5 from ground looking up into the sky)

With th' angelic host proclaim, (pic of preschoolers dressed as angels)

"Christ is born in Bethlehem!" (pic of nativity & baby Jesus – SS students dressed up)

Refrain: Hark! The herald angels sing, "Glory to the newborn King!" (Group SS photo)

- 5. Learning Fair Project:** Since we are sending items to Ukraine, someone could present a poster or tri-fold report on what Christmas is like in Ukraine. It could include some of Ukraine's history & current events. (Think of what you do for school projects). I'd like to have this displayed by December 15<sup>th</sup>, and leave it up through New Years day.
- 6. Servant Event:** Greeting at the south door the night of the 21<sup>st</sup>. You would be smiling and greeting each person coming in and out while holding the door open for people from 5:10-6:55 pm.
